

AFTER CARE WORKSHEET

Trus with Biopsy

You may experience some of the following situations:

Blood in your urine:

This is normal for the first 48 hours after this procedure

Blood in your stool:

This is normal for the first few bowel movements after the procedure.

Cramping

Tenderness with urination.

Tenderness with bowel movement.

Please Call the Office if you are having the following:

Pain that is getting worse instead of better.

Fever, 101.5 or greater

Passing multiple blood clots

Please go to the emergency room if you are having:

Uncontrollable bleeding in urine (blood clots)

Follow Up Appointment

You should have a follow up appointment made prior to leaving the office after your procedure.

This appointment will be made 10-14 days after the procedure so that we will have the results from the Pathologist.

During this visit the doctor will review the results of the procedure.

Our doctors do not allow the nurse/ medical assistant to give ot the result from a Biopsy, so you must come into the office for your follow up to receive the results
